



ASSEMBLY OF PRINCIPALS AND ELECTORS

An Assembly of Principals, Officers and Electors of the Parish of St Martin was duly convened and held in the Public Hall on Monday 9th November 2020 at 7.30 pm.

The Connétable welcomed all present, and reminded the Assembly that they could sign the Attendance Book at the end of the meeting if they had not already done so. The Convening Notice was read by the Parish Secretary and apologies were received from Reverend Jonny Scott, Paul Gaudin and Stuart McAllister

Item 1

Receive and if deemed advisable, approve the Minutes of the Parish Assembly held on the 6th October 2020.

The Connétable pointed out that the Minutes had been available in the Public Hall office and that copies were also on the seats in the Hall. Mr Alexander Assman queried the signing of the Minutes by the Connétable as the Connétable was absent at the Parish Assembly held on 6th October. Deputy Steve Luce replied that the Connétable was signing the Minutes on behalf of the Assembly who were present at the meeting on 6th October. Connétable Stone advised this will be confirmed with the Law Office. Deputy Steven Luce proposed the Minutes were accepted and this was seconded by Lester Richardson. A show of hands showed 11 in favour and 1 against. The Minutes remain unsigned pending response from the Law Offices.

Mr Emmanuel explained that this hotel has been in business for many years and is currently in the process of changing management to Mr Renzo Martin. All the relevant reports required for this application have been submitted to the Connétable. An Al Fresco licence has also been confirmed with the Ports of Jersey. Drawing plans for the Al Fresco seating area have been submitted to the Connétable. Mr Emmanuel added that there were no changes to the current licence other than change of name from Walker Properties Ltd.

The Connétable asked if there were any questions from those present and there being none asked for a proposer for the application.

Mr Gerald Le Cocq proposed this application and stated that the property has previously been superbly run by Mr Renzo Martin since 1975 and that he was very much in favour of accepting this application. Mr Peter Germain seconded the application. A show of hands showed it was unanimously accepted.
