



MINUTES OF A NOMINATION MEETING OF PRINCIPALS AND ELECTORS

PURSUANT to an Act of the Royal Court dated 13th October 2023, whereby it was ordered that an election be held for Centenier, the current term of office due to expire in December 2023.

In accordance with the Public Elections (Jersey) Law, 2002, an Assembly of the Electors of the Parish of St. Martin was held at the Public Hall on Tuesday 21st November 2023 at 7.00 pm to proceed with the Election in conformity with the aforesaid Act of the Royal Court.

The Connétable welcomed all present and reminded the Assembly that they could sign the Attendance Book at the end of the meeting if they so wished. It was noted that 28 parishioners attended the Assembly.

Apologies were received from Deputy Stephen Luce. The Convening Notice was read by the Parish Secretary.

The Connétable confirmed that a nomination form had been received for Teresa Roland which was completed by a proposer Steven Falle, and nine seconders who are electors of the Parish. The Connétable invited Steven Falle to address the Assembly.

Steven Falle read the nine seconders:

Steven stated that Teresa first served in Honorary Police as a Constable's Officer in 2002 for the Vingtaine de Faldouet, was elected as a Centenier in 2020 and is currently serving as Vice President for the Honorary Police Association. Originally from Guernsey, Teresa moved to Jersey in 1977 working for the finance industry. Teresa is an accomplished target shooter representing both the GB Team and the Guernsey Commonwealth Team in previous Games, along with assisting in judging in the London Olympic Games in 2012. Steven added that he was very happy to propose Teresa for the role of Centenier.

The Connétable asked if there were any other nominations and, after a period of ten minutes and no further nominations, declared Teresa Roland was duly elected as a

Centenier and warned to appear at the Royal Court at 10am on Friday 15th December to take her Oath of Office.

The Connétable then gave thanks to Centenier Roland for her commitment to the Parish in her role as Centenier, especially with her assistance at Firearms interviews.
