1. Agenda, Apologies and Conflicts of Interest:

No conflicts of interest were noted.

2. Minutes of Previous Meeting held on Monday 3rd November 2025.

The Minutes were approved and signed by the Connétable.

3. Action Points & Matters Arising:

Weed Growth along Parish Roads

It was noted that a spray had been undertaken free of charge and that this would be repeated at the beginning of April 2026 as per the agreed fee.

Rue de la Ville Bree – Road Resurfacing Works

It was noted that CA had previously chased the contractor for a response and would do so again after the meeting.

Petrol Costs

It was noted that the petrol costs for the Grounds Team were solely apportioned to the Committee's budget. CA was requested to review whether this was the case several years back.

Visite Royale – Guest List

The Committee reviewed the guest list from 2022 and made some suggestions regarding potential Voyeurs. CA was requested to draft a list for further consideration by the Committee and the Procureurs. In addition CA was requested to distribute any paperwork relevant to the areas the Court might be asked to review.

La Huterie

It was noted that the potholes had been kindly repaired by ADM.

Rue de la Genestiere

It was noted that the matter was currently being reviewed by the Planning Department.

4. La Rue de la Solitude

The Committee discussed the quote from Infrastructure for completing the yellow lines and posts at La Rue de la Solitude. The Committee accepted the quote and hoped the works could be undertaken without further delay.

5. Road Resurfacing Works Update

La Rue de la Vignette:

It was noted that the fillet remained outstanding but it was hoped this would be completed within the next few weeks.

La Longue Rue:

It was noted that the majority of works had been completed and it looked as though completion would be achieved within the next few days.

La Ruette:

It was noted that the majority of trenching appeared to be completed and it was agreed that CA would contact the developer for an update.

6. Planning

It was noted that Rochefort was located on a Government road and so the Committee agreed that it would not be appropriate for the Parish to comment on the proposed roadside parking.

7. Le Mont des Ormes

It was noted that there were some potholes along Le Mont des Ormes and it was agreed that these would be reviewed as part of the annual inspection to be carried out by the Roads Inspectors. CA was therefore requested to contact the Roads Inspectors and ask them to undertake a pothole and road sign review for their respective Vingtaines by the first week of January.

8. Budget Update

The Committee reviewed the expenditure to date and noted the remaining available funds.

9. Meeting Schedule for 2026

Members of the Committee agreed to review the draft meeting schedule prior to the meeting in January 2026.

10. AOB

Rue de la Palloterie

It was noted that there was still a strong smell of oil along La Rue de la Palloterie. CA advised that Pollution Control was fully aware of the situation and that remediation works were currently being undertaken.

La Rue de la Chouquerie

It was noted that there was a gap between the road and the wall and it was agreed to review this during the site visit after the meeting.

Rue de Bassacre

It was noted that lorries appeared to be going over the kerb along Rue de Bassacre. It was agreed to review during the site visit.

Maufant Sewage Tank Proposal

CA was requested to contact Infrastructure to make sure the Committee was consulted in relation to the Traffic Management Plan for the proposed development of the sewage tank in Maufant.

La Chasse du Mourin

Clarification was sought on the ownership of a triangle of land to the rear of Maufant Village to clarify maintenance of the drain. It was agreed this would be reviewed during the site visit.

Site Visit Notes:

La Rue de la Chouquerie

The Committee reviewed the drain opening and it was noted that there was a strong likelihood that the area in question was within the Parish of St Saviour. It was agreed that this would be further reviewed in the office.

Rue de Bassacre

The Committee reviewed the kerb and did not see a lot of damage. However, it was felt that some appropriate logs strategically placed would help prevent any future damage.

La Chasse du Mourin

It was noted the triangle of land was in the Parish of St Martin and it was likely that formed part of Field S229.
