



**MINUTES OF A
NOMINATION MEETING OF PRINCIPALS AND ELECTORS
7PM, THURSDAY 5th FEBRUARY 2026**

The Connétable welcomed all present and reminded the Assembly that they could sign the Attendance Book at the end of the meeting if they so wished. It was noted that 25 parishioners were in attendance.

- Apologies were received from Peter Germain. The Convening Notice was read by the Parish Secretary.

1. To elect one Centenier to complete a three-year term of office expiring March 2029.

Pursuant to an Act of the Royal Court dated 9th January 2026, whereby it was ordered that an election be held for Centenier, this nomination meeting has been called to elect one Centenier to complete a three-year term of office expiring March 2029.

The Connétable confirmed that one nomination form had been received for Anne Kathryn Stone which was completed by proposer Paulette De La Haye, and nine seconders who are electors of the Parish. The Connétable invited Paulette De La Haye to address the Assembly.

Mrs De La Haye advised the Assembly that it was her great pleasure to propose Anne Stone for the position of Centenier for St. Martin. Mrs De La Haye had known Anne for 3 years since Mrs Stone had moved to the Parish with her husband Pete, in his role as Parish Rector. Anne and Pete have 2 children, Essie and Joshua, both of whom work and live in the U.K.

Anne had qualified as a Registered General Nurse 23 years ago and had since gained a further qualification as a Emergency Nurse Practitioner. She was currently studying for her Masters in Advanced Practice. Anne very much relishes the challenge of working in the Accident & Emergency Department and is well used to working under pressure.

In 2024 Anne made local history by becoming the first Civilian Officer in the Honorary Police system. She progressed to a Constable's Officer in 2025.

Mrs De La Haye highlighted that Anne was wholehearted in her voluntary work for the Parish which she undertakes in a kind, compassionate and calm manner, even in stressful circumstances. Mrs De La Haye felt that Anne had considerable diplomatic skills and that St. Martin would be truly blessed to have her as a Centenier.
