



## MINUTES OF AN ASSEMBLY OF PRINCIPALS, OFFICERS AND ELECTORS

An Assembly of Principals, Officers and Electors of the Parish of St Martin was duly convened and held in the Public Hall on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March 2026 at 7.00 pm.

The Connétable welcomed all present, and reminded the Assembly that they could sign the Attendance Book at the end of the meeting if they had not already done so. It was noted that there were 15 in attendance at the Assembly.

The Convening Notice was read by the Parish Secretary and it was noted that no apologies had been received.

### *Item 1*

***Receive, and if deemed advisable, approve the Minutes of the Parish Assembly and the Nomination Meeting held on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> February 2026.***

The Connétable stated that both sets of Minutes had been available at the Public Hall office and that copies were also on the seats in the Hall.

Mr Lester Richardson proposed the Minutes of the Parish Assembly be accepted and this was seconded by Mr William Sutton. A show of hands showed a majority in favour and none against. The Minutes were signed by the Connétable.

Rev. Peter Stone proposed the Minutes of the Nomination Meeting be accepted and this was seconded by Mr Peter Searle. A show of hands showed a majority in favour and none against. The Minutes were signed by the Connétable.

### *Item 2*

***To elect an Officer du Connétable for the Vingtaine de l'Eglise for a three-year term of office.***

The Connétable stated that there was currently a vacancy for the Vingtaine de l'Eglise and a nomination had been received for Sheila Crowsley. The Assembly was advised that Mrs Crowsley had been an Officer du Connétable for St Peter until she moved to St Martin at the end of last year. The Connétable was delighted that Mrs Crowsley had chosen to join the ranks of St Martin's Honorary Police.

The Connétable requested a proposer and seconder for this nomination.

Mr Alan Mollet proposed the nomination and advised the Assembly that he had known Mrs Crowsley for a number of years. Mrs Crowsley had been a teacher at St Peter for nearly 20 years and was a keen scuba diver in her spare time. He considered that she would be a great asset for the Honorary Police and had much pleasure in proposing her for the post.

Mr Peter Wrigglesworth seconded the proposal and fully endorsed the words of Mr Mollet.

The Connétable asked if there were any other nominations and, there being none, declared Mrs Crowsley duly elected as Officer du Connétable for the Vingtaine de l'Elgise.

The Connétable congratulated Mrs Crowsley on her election and warned her to present herself at the Royal Court on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> April at 10am to take her Oath of Office.

***Item 3***

***To elect an Officer du Connétable for the Vingtaine de Rozel for a three-year term of office.***

The Connétable stated that there was currently a vacancy for the Vingtaine de Rozel and a nomination had been received for Alex Morton. The Connétable was delighted that Mr Morton was interested in joining the Honorary Police and it was particularly heartening to see a young person wanting to take up the role.

The Connétable requested a proposer and seconder for this nomination.

Mr Alan Phillips proposed the nomination and advised the Assembly that Mr Morton worked in IT and had demonstrated a high level of enthusiasm for joining the Honorary Police. Mr Phillips was delighted to be able to nominate Mr Morton and welcome him to the ranks.

Rev. Pete Stone seconded the proposal and fully endorsed the words of Mr Phillips. He welcomed Mr Morton to the Parish and remarked how great it was to have two new recruits to the Honorary Police.

The Connétable asked if there were any other nominations and, there being none, declared Mr Morton duly elected as Officer du Connétable for the Vingtaine de Rozel.

The Connétable congratulated Mr Morton on his election and warned him to present himself at the Royal Court on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> April at 10am to take his Oath of Office.

There being no further business the Connétable thanked everyone for attending and declared the meeting closed at 7.12 pm.
