1. Agenda, Apologies and Conflicts of Interest:

No conflicts of interest were noted.

2. Minutes of Previous Meeting held on Tuesday 14th April 2026.

The Minutes of the Meeting on 14th April were approved and signed by the Connétable.

3. Action Points & Matters Arising:

Road Sweeping Contract:

It was noted that the contract included the usage of smaller sweepers for those less accessible lanes such as by Moonrakers and Fliquet.

It was agreed that a meeting would be held with the contractor at the Public Hall to discuss a 2 year extension of the contract.

Rue de la Perruque – Field Entrance:

CA was requested to contact the owners for an update on the planning situation.

Rue du Moulin – Cobbled Area:

It was noted that the Parish was awaiting a copy of the relevant contract.

Mont de la Guerande – Mains Water Connection:

MJ confirmed that he had spoken to Brenwal and requested over banding in relation to the reinstatement of trenched areas.

Wayleave rights were discussed and it was suggested this could be considered as part of the ongoing Road Law review. It was crucial that all of the Parishes adopted a similar approach.

St John's Ambulance:

It was noted that St John's Ambulance had been advised of the Committee's concerns in relation to the re-development of their site.

Hedges at Springside and Beauvoir:

4. Pothole Reports

It was noted that the pothole repairs were due to take place during the latter part of the month. The schedule of repairs included Rue de Basacre.

5. Speed Review – Mont des Landes

It was agreed that the matter would be further reviewed once the revised proposals had been submitted by Infrastructure. CA was requested to clarify the timeline for the Speed Review following the recent public consultation exercise.

6. Unauthorised Field Entrances

CA was requested to write to both property owners requesting clarification on the unauthorised field entrances.

7. Budget Update

The Committee reviewed the budget summary and noted that one figure has been potentially replicated. Overall it was noted that the Committee's expenditure was in line with the budget for the year.

8. Field 410 – Appeal Hearing

It was noted that PS and DW would be attending the Appeal to convey the concerns of the Committee and the Parish as a whole.

9. Parish Road Signs and La Rue du Moulin

It was noted that Infrastructure was wholly responsible for signage on Government owned roads. In relation to the recent accident that had occurred on Rue du Moulin by St Catherine's woods it was suggested that a stop sign with white line might provide a more enhanced warning for drivers, particularly if they were visitors or recent residents. CA was requested to convey the Roads Committee's observations to the Infrastructure Department.

10. Oak Trees – La Grande Route de Faldouet

It was agreed that MJ would contact the contractor/tenant responsible for managing the land to discuss the ivy and dead wood on the relevant oak trees.

11. AOB

La Cour Normande – Works to Entrance:

The Committee had no objection to the proposed works to the entrance of La Cour Normande.

Visite Royale Route:

It was agreed that the Committee would review the route after the meeting and thereafter submit it to the Chef de Police.
