1. Agenda, Apologies and Conflicts of Interest:

No conflicts of interest were noted.

2. Minutes of Previous Meeting held on Monday 11th May 2026.

The Minutes of the Meeting on Monday 11th May were approved and signed by the Connétable.

3. Action Points & Matters Arising:

(i) Road Sweeping Contract:

It was noted that a meeting would be arranged after the forthcoming elections.

(ii) Unauthorised Field Entrances:

It was noted that a formal request had now been submitted by the property owner on La Rue des Marettes for a temporary entrance for a 10 month period whilst the refurbishment works were taking place. This was approved by the Committee. It was recommended that the owner be requested to review their roadside hedge which was increasingly leaning outward.

It was noted that no response had been received from the property owner on La Rue de la Perruque. CA was requested to follow this up.

(iii) Rue du Moulin – Cobbled Area:

Ongoing.

(iv) Outward Leaning Hedges:

It was noted that one owner was actively addressing the issue whilst the ongoing problem along La Route de la Cote would be addressed at the forthcoming Visite Royale.

- (v) Speed Review:
It was noted that CA was awaiting an update from Infrastructure.
- (vi) Rue du Moulin:
It was noted that CA was awaiting a response from Infrastructure.
- (vii) Oak Trees along La Grande Route de Faldouet
It was noted that MJ was discussing the issue with the tenant's contractor.
- (viii) Visite Royale
It was noted that the provisional route had been submitted to the Honorary Police for their consideration.

4. Pothole Repairs

It was noted that some of the proposed repairs had been delayed due to the recent hot weather. In addition a pothole had surfaced at Rue de Bassacre adjacent to a previous repair. It was agreed that a temporary repair would be undertaken by the Lands Team as it was likely that a more significant panel repair would be required in the near future.

5. Field 410 Appeal Hearing

It was noted that DW and PS had attended the Appeal and advised the Inspector about the proposed reduction in speed limit to 20mph. They had also given the Committee's views on the splay lines etc.

6. Mont de la Guerande – Road Camber

It was noted that a request had been received from a Parishioner living along Mont de la Guerande. The Parishioner was requesting permission to reduce the camber at the corner of his property by inserting some steps and a new drainage gully.

It was agreed that it would be prudent to have a site meeting and CA was requested to arrange a suitable time following on from the Committee meeting on 6th July.

7. Budget for 2026/2027

It was noted that the Parish would shortly be preparing a budget for the new financial year. DW requested that the Committee should have the same budget as 2025/2026 with a cost of living uplift. It was acknowledged that costs continued to rise and the maintenance of roads was no exception in this respect.

8. AOB

It was agreed that one mini-bus would be sufficient for the branchage visit in July.
