1. Agenda, Apologies and Conflicts of Interest:

No conflicts of interest were noted.

2. Minutes of Previous Meeting held on Monday 11th May 2026.

The Minutes of the Meeting on Monday 11th May were approved and signed by the Connétable.

3. Action Points & Matters Arising:

(i) Road Sweeping Contract:
Ongoing

(ii) Unauthorised Field Entrances:
It was noted that the owner of the property along La Rue de la Perruque had indicated that they were not intending to use the field entrance on a regular basis. It was therefore agreed that the entrance could remain in situ but if the owners did wish to use it more regularly they would need to contact the Roads Committee accordingly.

(iii) Rue du Moulin – Cobbled Area:
CA had now received the sale contracts but they remained silent on the ownership of the cobbled area.

(iv) Speed Review:
It was noted that Infrastructure had provided an update. However, given the required legal amendments and Ministerial approvals, it was likely that it would take several months before the speed limit changes were implemented.

- (v) Rue du Moulin:
It was noted that Infrastructure was actively reviewing the situation.
- (vi) Oak Trees along La Grande Route de Faldouet
It was noted that some of the tree limbs were due to be tidied up in the near future.
- (vii) Rue de Bassacre – Pothole Repair
It was noted that the Parish team had undertaken a temporary repair.
- (viii) Mont de la Guerande – Camber Review
It was noted that a meeting had been arranged with the owner of the property at 11 am.

4. Rue de Neuilly – Outstanding Works

It was noted that matters were ongoing and the contractor was due to have a meeting with MJ in the near future.

5. La Grande Route de Faldouet – Parking Restriction Request

It was noted that the Parish had been contacted by Infrastructure regarding a request to place a time limit on parking opposite the former Browns Garage. The Committee noted that no other complaints had been received to date and that there did not appear to be a significant problem at this juncture. It was therefore suggested that the matter remain under review for the time being.

6. Budget for 2026/2027

It was noted that although there was some underspend over the last financial year this was solely due to a timing issue and the contractors not being able to complete the works by the end of April. It was suggested that the second pothole review may need to be scheduled for January/February to allow adequate time for the repairs to be completed.

It was noted that the forthcoming budget for 2026/2027 would provide an uplift in line with RPI. In addition the Connétable and Procureurs would consider a request for additional funds to reflect the underspend that had occurred, subject to the necessary funds being available.

7. Planning Applications – Rose Lea

It was agreed that the Parish would enquire whether a traffic management plan would be submitted as part of the application given the potential intensification of traffic along La Chasse des Demoiselles Bandinel.

8. Visite Royale – Roads Report

It was noted that CA would prepare a brief report detailing expenditure on the Parish roads over the last financial year.

9. AOB

DW requested that the Parish team clean the abreuvoir along La Rue des Vaux de l'Eglise.

10. Site Visit Notes

Field 494 – Roadside Kerb Proposal

It was agreed that a level kerb could be fitted between the field entrance and the tarmac of the Parish road. It was noted the field owner had agreed to repair any tarmac that had been eroded over time.

La Vielle Charriere – Pine Tree Root

It was acknowledged that either the tree root needed to be dug up and cut back or alternatively a warning sign or post installed. It was agreed to further review at the meeting in August.

Mont de la Guerande

The Committee was advised that the property owner wished to undertake significant levelling works to create a turning circle for vehicles including refuse lorries. The levelling works would necessitate the creation of a small number of steps on the Parish pathway as well as revised drainage provision.

The Committee agreed to ascertain the area required for a turning circle for the refuse lorries so that this could be incorporated within any plans. It was noted that the Committee would further review the matter once the scale and extent of the works had been clarified.
